The Mount Boucherie Secondary School Hairstylist Foundation Program provides students with a well-diversified perspective of the art and science of hairdressing. This 1290 hour foundation level program starts in September each year and provides students with 990 hours of in-class instruction as well as a 300 hour practicum placement at a local established hair salon. Students can continue on to earn their Red Seal certification after successful completion of this foundation program.

Throughout the program students will be exposed to real-life situations that help prepare them for industry standards and expectations in the labor market. This is accomplished through an industry practicum placement for students as well as a variety of in-class instructional practices that foster a creative mind set and allow the students to learn through experiential discovery. Students typically complete their English 12 graduation requirement during the program if required.

Students in the program will be registered as ITA Youth TRAIN students under the sponsorship of the Central Okanagan Public Schools.

## Admission Requirements

- SD23 registered student of school age
- Reliable transportation to Mount Boucherie Secondary school
- English 11 completed

## Graduation Requirements

Students must complete the following requirements to be successful in the Foundation program.

- 990 hours of theory with a minimum mark of 70%
- 300 hours of practicum placement hours
- Skilled Trades Standard Level Exam

## Red Seal Certification requirements

After completion of the Foundation program (Level 1) students can register for Level 2 at an accredited post-secondary training institute. To earn a Red Seal certification students must complete:

- both Levels 1 & 2 of in-school training
- 3150 hours (work and school)
- Red Seal written and practical exam
- Recommendation for Certification (by employer)

## Fees

SD23 Pays: Tuition: valued at approx. \$12,000 if taken at a private post-secondary institute.

Students Pays: \$ 950.00
