This course is an admission requirement for the Practical Nursing (PN) that provides an overview of the structure and function of the body systems. Various health promotion strategies that work toward optimal function of these systems are discussed. PNUR 113 is delivered online only through distance education.

Admission Requirements

Grade 12 student with good attendance and academic standing on a Dogwood graduation plan. A minimum grade of 67% in a Grade 12 Biology course which includes human anatomy and physiology. However, students with a minimum grade of 80% in their Biology 11 course may take Biology 12 as a corequisite.

English Requirements

Students can also be working on English 12 and Biology 12 concurrently while in PNUR 113.

Graduation Requirements

A minimum passing grade of 70% in all courses in the program

Program Delivery via Okanagan College

Delivered by Distance Education. Computer based, asynchronous, tutor-supported (no direct instruction) Students are not required to be online at a specific time. Exams are written at home using Respondus Lockdown Browser and Monitor. Webcam is required as test sessions are recorded.
