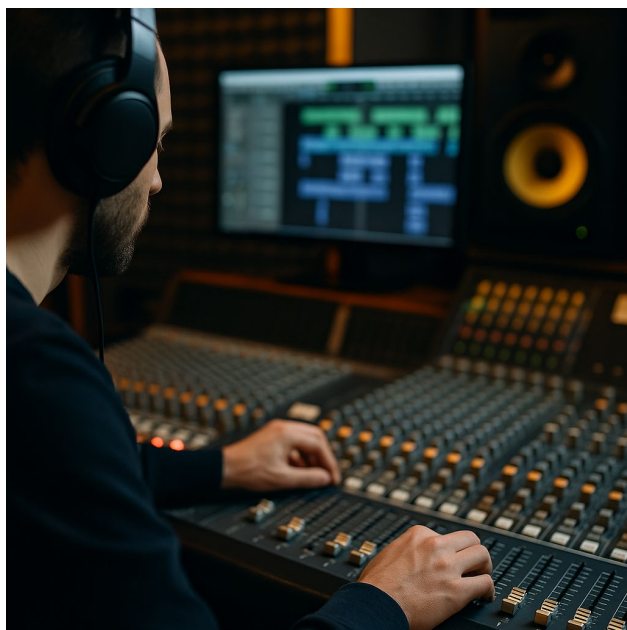


SOUNDSTART: AUDIO ENGINEERING

- Using audio tracks, samples, and filters
- Creating loops, FX, and musical compositions
- Exploring rhythm, phrasing, and sound design
